ABOUT THESE AWARDS

CBWN is calling on members to nominate women who live, work or study on the Central Coast, who deserve recognition of strength and courage through challenging times.

WHAT IS RESILIENCE?

Resilience is defined as the ability to 'bounce back' – to recover effectively from trauma, tragedy and other significant setbacks. Resilient people do not let adversity define them, but rather, realise the strength within them and return to a productive life, often making a valued contribution to their community.

NOMINATIONS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

These awards are open to all women over the age of 18 across the Central Coast (excluding employees and volunteers of Iris Foundation).

Nominations will be assessed on nominator's written responses and any appropriate supporting materials submitted (e.g. resumes, personal references, press coverage etc).

All information supporting the nomination will be kept confidential and viewed only by the independent assessment panel. Multiple nominations do not increase the chance of winning. The decision of the assessment panel is final.
